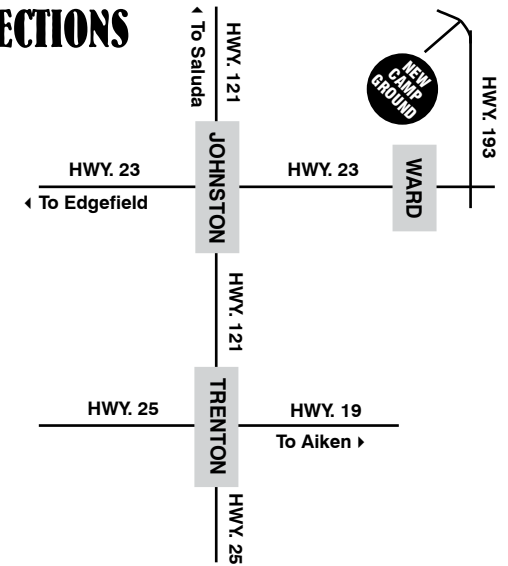

DIRECTIONS



IMPORTANT NOTES

- The campground will open at 12:00 noon on Wednesday prior to the ride for parking and camp setup. There will be NO saving campsites prior to Wednesday.
- The water system will not be working, but there will be plenty of water tankers, and the showers will be working with plenty of hot water.
- Anyone saving a spot MUST park a truck, trailer or camper in the spot – POSITIVELY NO ROPING OFF unless authorized by Ward SC Events staff.
- Each person camping or holding a spot prior to Friday AM will be charged \$45 per person.
- NO four-wheelers allowed except for staff.
- All golf carts must have a proof of insurance certificate, and it must be attached to the registration.
- Persons without a valid driver's license may NOT operate a golfcart on trail ride property.
- Absolutely NO playing on golfcarts.
- **Absolutely NO dogs allowed on trails. All dogs must be kept on leash in campground.**
- Hoses will NOT be permitted to hook to water tankers.
- NO parking sideways – must park perpendicular to trees or spot unless approved by Ward SC Events staff.
- NO motorcycles in camp – they may park at campground entrance.
- NO guns, fireworks or bullwhips may be discharged on property.
- NO non-contained campfires – must bring fire ring; no digging holes for fires.
- There are no electric hook-ups – please bring your generator.
- 5 MPH speed limit in campground.
- QUIET TIME enforced 1 hour after entertainment. No wandering or disruptive activities during quiet time. This will be strictly enforced!
- Campground gates will be closed every night at 1:30 AM and will re-open at 7:00 AM. Security will be on duty.
